### Entries deadlines:

Provisional entries: **11.12.2025**

Final entries: **15.01.2026**





## Liability

All athletes, officials, and members of National Ski Associations, who attend and participate in the event, shall do so at their own risk. Upon starting, every competitor confirms that he/she acknowledge the race course and safety precautions as adequate. Above all, the Organising committee, Bansko Resort, the FIS, Bulgarian Ski Federation, race staff, sponsor and suppliers, their agents, employees, and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organising or staging of the event.

## Insurance

Each NSA is responsible for providing sufficient insurance for its participants – athletes and officials (ICR art. 204.2, 212.3, 212.4).

## Participation fee

In accordance with FIS EC Rules (Art. 5.1.1), a participation fee (incl. lift ticket) of **€50** per athlete and **€25 per coach** per training and race day must be paid at the Race Office during the team's registration and accreditation. The payment is by credit card or in cash.

## Registration / Accreditation

Teams' registration and accreditation start at 6:00 PM on 18 January at the Race Office at Hotel Four Points by Sheraton, 7 Glazne Str, 2770 Bansko.

The teams will be accommodated at hotels meeting the official FIS requirements on a board basis (breakfast and dinner) at the FIS rates:

**80 CHF** – per person per day accommodated in Double Room

**125 CHF** – per person per day accommodated in Single Room

Accommodation expenses must be paid at the **Accommodation Office**, located at Hotel Four Points by Sheraton Bansko.

Upon request, the teams may receive an additional offer for early arrival or late departure.

For those requiring transfers from or to **Sofia Airport**, our logistics partner **BALKAN HOLIDAYS Services** can organize either **shared shuttle or individual transfers** between Sofia Airport and Bansko.

Please kindly submit your flight details to **BALKAN HOLIDAYS Services** to ensure the best possible offers and timely arrangements.

Team transfer requests must include the following information:

- Number of people - including athletes, staff, and officials
- Arrival and/or departure dates
- Flight details - origin and destination, flight number, arrival/departure time, and terminal at Sofia Airport for each flight
- Luggage details - number of bags, with approximate weight and dimensions for each, important for transfer arrangements.

### *Transportation & Parking in the race venue*

The primary way to reach the race venue is via the Gondola, conveniently located just a short walk from the teams' hotel (approximately 150 meters, 2-3 minutes on foot).





A limited number of parking spaces will be available near the Finish area for teams. Parking permits will be allocated according to team size and can be collected from the Race Office during team registration.

### Working spaces

Working spaces for service personnel will be provided in containers located at the Gondola bottom station parking lot. Ski room keys can be picked up and returned at the Race Office (Hotel Four Points by Sheraton).



### Travel to Bansko:

**By air:** The OC strongly recommends flying to Sofia Airport; Balkan Holidays, the logistics partner of the OC, can organize transfers between Sofia Airport and Bansko (see the information above).

**By car:** Bansko is located in the southwestern part of Bulgaria, in the heart of the majestic Pirin Mountains. It is approximately a two-hour drive from Sofia, and there are several possible routes.

The quickest and most convenient route is **via the main E79** highway south to **Simitli**, then following the clearly marked eastbound turn through **Predela Pass** all the way to Bansko. Road conditions are generally good, but winter tyres are mandatory during the winter season.
